1,	The school will follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time.
2.	The School is required to apply on online for further extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 Affiliation Bye Laws.
3.	The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned as mentioned in certificate as per appendix issued by District Education Officer (DEO) /equivalent officer.
4.	The school should ensure the strong governance and management of its activities in way of comprehensive and quantifiable planning in way curriculum planning, infrastructure, resources, physical education, staff development and other co-curricular areas.
5.	The school should go through the provision of Affillation and Examination Bye Laws and keep a copy there of for reference purpose and all advised to visit CBSE websites i.e. http://cbseacademic.nic.in/ & http://cbse.nic.in/ for updates. The School is expected to see all circulars on the CBSE websites regularly.
6	The school will strictly adhere to all rules regarding safety of students including Fire fighting and Transportation, etc. Further, school will provide adequate facilities for potable drinking water and clean healthy and hygienic toilets with washing facilities for boys and girls separately in proportion the number of students.
7.	Admission to the school is to be restricted as per relevant rules of Examination Bye-laws and rule 2.4.5, 2.6.5, 7.1, 7.2, 8.4.2, 8.4.10 & other relevant rules of Affiliation bye laws.
8.	The school is required to follow rule No.2.4.7 and 2.4.8 of Affiliation Bye Laws regarding Books and Quality of Education. Contd
9,	The number of sections in the school are restricted to 78 as per number of sections reported by the IC and shall not be increased without specific approval of the Board. For increase in number of sections, the School shall apply online to the Board as per rule 15.7 of affiliation by

14	Every affiliated school shall sponsor regularly its bonafide and eligible students in Boards Class X and Class XII examinations from the year mentione while granting affiliation/upgradation regularly without break or inform with reasons thereof in writing well in time about the non-sponsoring of the candidates.
15	Running of coaching institutions in the school premises in the pretext of providing coaching to the students for various examinations is not permitte by the Board. Strict action would be taken on defaulters.
6	The Manger and the Principal of the school shall be jointly responsible for the authenticity of the online/offline documents/ information/data submitte by the School to the Board.
