CLASS I & II

The evaluation process of class I and class II is according to the early education development program (EEDP) introduced by the DAV Education Board.

The program designed intends to help children grow, learn and develop physically, socially, emotionally, morally and intellectually, thus leading to the holistic development of these students.

Child is evaluated on the basis of his/her day to day performance.

Formal tests are not conducted. To check the clarity of concepts, small assessments are held as class test/surprise test at the end of the particular chapter or at the end of particular concept.

NOTE: To motivate the students and to show their graph of improvement, we follow the following grading system:

- A Always
- S−Sometimes
- U-Usually

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N−Needs Improvement

SCHEME OF ASSESSMENT CLASSES III TO VII
